

Structure of Japan's ODA Schemes






- 1962 Establishment of the Overseas Technical Cooperation Agency (OTCA, predecessor of JICA)

About JICA Türkiye Office-1

•JICA's first cooperation activity in Türkiye was "Acceptance of Trainees", which was launched in 1959.

•JICA Türkiye Office was established in Ankara, Türkiye in June 1995 as the 52nd overseas office of JICA.

•As of 2021, the accumulated budget allocation for Technical Cooperation towards Türkiye is around **46.655 billion JPY** (app. 421 mil. USD), and accumulated commitment of ODA Loan to Türkiye is **780.63 billion JPY** (5.4 billion USD).



About JICA Türkiye Office-2

As of June 2019; app. 4,000 Turkish officials participated in the training programs in Japan, and 1,185 Turkish officials were trained in Türkiye.

•JICA dispatched about 1,600 experts to Türkiye,

•Total number of Senior Volunteers assigned to Türkiye reached to **72**, and

•Up to now, **42** Development Studies, **40** Technical Coop.tion Projects, and **20** TCTPs (**1,125** participants from **34** neighbouring countries for **80** courses) were implemented.

•JICA implemented **29** ODA Loans in Türkiye including <u>Marmaray Project</u> and <u>2nd Bosporus Bridge</u>.

[TK-P20] Municipal Sewerage and Wastewater Treatment Improvement Project

Project Objective: To improve sewerage, wastewater treatment and stormwater network in middle size municipalities in Türkiye whose infrastructure are behind compared to large sized municipalities in order to promote sewerage and wastewater treatment prevalence and to improve water quality of rivers, thereby contributing to improvement of living conditions of local residents and reducing disparities.

Target Municipalities: Kadirli (Osmaniye), Reyhanlı (Hatay), Orhangazi (Bursa), Tekirdağ Central, Çan (Çanakkale), Kütahya Central, Kuşadası (Aydın), Osmaniye Central

Totally 21 sewerage water, storm water and wastewater treatment projects were constructed.



Loan Agreement Date: 22 June 2011

Loan Closing date : 26 July 2021 (with 2-year extension) including Defect Liability Period

Loan Amount: 12,874,000,000 JPY

Repayment Period: 25 years, including 7 years of grace period



[TK-P21] Local Authorities Infrastructure Improvement Project

Project Objective: To improve infrastructure services of target municipalities and Water and Sewerage Utilities affected by Syrians who are under temporary protection in Türkiye by providing long-term finance to infrastructure projects through Iller Bank, thereby contributing improvement of living conditions of people.

Target Municipalities: Adana (ASKI), Osmaniye, Hatay (HATSU), Kahramanmaraş (KASKI), Kilis, Gaziantep MM and GASKI, Malatya, Şanlıurfa (SUSKI)

More than 100 projects water, wastewater including stormwater management and solid waste management construction and vehicle purchase



Loan Agreement Date: 15 May 2015

Loan Closing date : 14 August 2025

Loan Amount: 45,000,000,000 JPY

Repayment Period: 25 years, including 7 years of grace period



[TK-P22] Local Authorities Environmental Improvement Project

Project Objective: To promote the development of social infrastructure including water supply, wastewater management and solid waste management, by providing long-term finance to social infrastructure in target provinces affected by influx of the Syrians who are under temporary protection in Türkiye, thereby contributing improvement of living conditions of these Syrians and host communities.

Target Municipalities: Adana, Ankara, Elazığ, Hatay, Kilis, Konya, Malatya, Mersin, Muş, and Şanlıurfa

Almost 30 large-scale projects will be implemented.



Loan Agreement Date: 20 August 2021

Loan Closing date : 2 November 2028

Loan Amount: 45,000,000,000 JPY

Repayment Period: 25 years, including 7 years of grace period

Target sectors: Water supply, wastewater management, solid waste management, and other sectors including urban transportation, and disaster management




JICA-DSI Ioan project [TK-P18] Ankara Water Supply Project

Project Objective: To develop water resources of Gerede Basin and to construct the related water supply facilities to cope with increasing water demand due to social economic activities towards development of Ankara.

Loan Amount: 26,826,000,000 JPY Loan Agreement Date: 28 December 2009 Loan Closing date : 18 April 2027 (1st extension: 2018-2022) (2nd extension: 2022-2027 with

addition of two sub-projects)

- Reconstructing of Çamlıdere-1 Prestressed Concrete Pipeline Between Kınık Tunnel Outlet and İvedik Water Treatment Plant Project
- Potable Water Facilities of Güdül, Beypazan, Ayaş, Çayırhan (Nallıhan) Districts of Ankara Province Located Downstream Side of Çamlıdere Dam Project
